
Alarm phases of emergency plan

ALWAYS sound the alarm via telephone number 100, even if the fire alarm button or fire alarm system has already been activated.

Assistance	For planned activities, the fire brigade's assistance is required		
	Alarm	No audible alarm	
0	Calamity that is limited to one department. Calamity with injury without external help.	Small fire, wounded person or an environmental incident; fire brigade or first aid needed, possible (emergency) shutdown of department, possible preventive evacuation.	
	 Alarm Fire or accident with hazardous substance Accident with injury 	 Audible alarm via emergency announcement system, followed by a message No audible alarm 	
1	Calamity that is limited to one department where external help is needed	Small fire, wounded person or an environmental incident; fire brigade needed, possible (emergency) stop of department, possible preventive evacuation.	
	Alarm Fire or accident with hazardous substance 	Audible alarm via emergency announcement system, followed by a message	
2	Calamity with consequences for other department(s) or calamity with injury requiring ambulance.	Large fire, environmental incident, injured person requiring external assistance, possible (emergency) stop of several departments, possible preventive evacuation.	
	Alarm Fire or accident with hazardous substance 	 Audible alarm via emergency announcement system, followed by a message No audible alarm 	
3	 Accident with injury Calamity with consequences outside the 	Large fire, environmental incident or multiple injured
